

Written Assignments

1. Written Assignments will be due both at the beginning and at the end of each Laboratory Section Meeting. You must be present during the Laboratory Section Meeting for the Assignment to be accepted. Late Assignments will be accepted only for excused absences.
2. At the beginning of each Laboratory Section Meeting, you are to turn in written answers for two of the Exercises from the previous period. The Exercises to be completed are listed on the back of this page. Answers that do not display the process by which they were obtained will be returned for further work. Each set of Exercises is worth 1/2 point.
3. An Activity Sheet is to be turned in at the end of each Laboratory Section Meeting. Each Activity Sheet is worth 1 point.
4. For Wednesday and Thursday periods following Group Meetings at which a video has been shown, write at least two paragraphs summarizing the video and what you see as the major issues presented by the video. The first assignment of this type is due on January 7 or January 8, depending on whether you attend a MW or TR Laboratory Section Meeting. While watching the videos, you should take notes to prepare for these assignments. Each of the seven video discussions is worth one point. Students who turn in all seven video summaries will receive one bonus point, making a total of eight video summary points.
5. The combined points from written assignments (Exercises, Laboratory Section Meeting, and Video Summaries) is 35 points.
